PUBLICATION OPPORTUNITIES: Submitted papers will be revised by part of the Programme Committee from the corresponding field. Selected papers will be published at journals **Facta Universitatis** and **Filomat**. The deadline for the full paper submission will be September 1st, 2014.

CONFERENCE FEE: The conference fee is 150 Euro, and 80 Euro for accompanying persons. The payment instructions will be given soon.

AWARD: Committee will assign award for achievements in mathematical sciences for researchers who are in 2014 at most 40 years old. The application deadline for candidates is February 1st, 2014, and the awarded author will hold plenary lecture.
